GUIDE TO MEETING SCHEDULE

Work Sessions. During Work Sessions, the Council considers Requests for Legislation and the preliminary drafts of items to be addressed on the floor of Business Meetings. Work Sessions also provide an opportunity for the Council to invite guests to discuss issues relevant to the City and its residents. Work Sessions are held at 6:00pm on the first and third Mondays of every month. These meetings are located in the City Council Work Room, through the City Clerk’s Office on the first floor of City Hall, 38 Hawley Street, Binghamton, NY.

Business Meetings. During Business Meetings, the Council votes on items such as budgetary transfers and Resolutions, Ordinances and Local Laws for the City of Binghamton. These meetings are open to the public, and early in the agenda, members of the public are allowed to address the Council for up to five minutes. Business Meetings are held at 6:30pm on the Wednesdays following Work Sessions, unless indicated otherwise on the calendar below. These meetings are located in the City Council Chambers, 38 Hawley Street, Binghamton, NY.
