Safety Town, a National Safety Education Program sponsored locally by the Binghamton Parks & Recreation Department, is a safety program for children entering Kindergarten or First Grade. Each day includes a presenter who speaks to the children, a craft, story books and riding the miniature cars on our Safety Town Village set up on the playground. Safety topics include:

- Riding in the Car/Crossing the street (presentation by Crossing Guard)
- Animal Safety (presentation by Binghamton Police Officer)
- Fire Safety (presentation by Fire department with Fire truck)
- Poison Safety (presentation by EMS)
- Bus Safety (presentation by First Student and a short bus ride)
- Stranger Danger (presentation by Crime Victims Assistance)
- Pool/Boat/Bathtub/Beach Safety (presentation by Lifeguard)
- Bike & Helmet Safety (presentation by Broome County Health Dept)
