**ITEMS CONSIDERED**

**Permanent Ordinance 14-5.** Council members reviewed Permanent Ordinance 14-5, entitled "An Ordinance amending the Code of the City of Binghamton regarding residency requirement for City of Binghamton employees", adopted on February 5, 2014. Councilman Berg suggested amending § 124-38 of the Code in part, to state the following:

**§ C-13. Eligibility. [L.L. No. 1-1951, § 1; L.L. No. 3-1955, § 1; L.L. No. 4-1962, § 1; L.L. No. 1-1963, § 1; L.L. No. 3-1966, § 2; L.L. No. 6-1977, § 1; L.L. No. 8-1977, § 1; L.L. No. 5-1978, § 1; Amended 1-22-08 by Ord. No. 3-2008; Amended 2-5-14 by Ord. No. 5-2014; Amended \_\_\_-\_\_\_-2014 by Ord. No. \_\_\_-2014]**

C. The Municipal Civil Service Commission shall, upon receipt of a request for a waiver of the residency requirement, forward such request, along with the reason for the submission of such request, to the Council of the City of Binghamton for review. Final approval of such requests rests with the Municipal Civil Service Commission. The Commission shall forward all determinations, including the date the waiver of residence requirement was granted, the date to which such waiver was granted, and the reason for the granting of the waiver, should such requested by granted, to the Council of the City of Binghamton as soon as such determination is made.

Council members generally agreed to such modification. Councilman Berg will submit a Request for Legislation to implement this modification during the Work Session immediately following this committee meeting.
