3. Reduce budget line A3120.52600 (Equipment—Bullet Proof Shield) from 1 @ \$1,500 to 0 @ \$1,500, a reduction of \$1,500; and
4. Reduce budget line A3120.52600 (Equipment—Portable Radio Headsets) from 8 @ \$500 to 0 @ \$500, a reduction of \$4,000.
