**Discussion.** The Municipal & Public Affairs Committee reviewed Introductory Local Law 13-4, entitled "A Local Law to establish a Public Arts Commission". A public hearing on this matter was held at the City Council Business Meeting held on December 18, 2013. Councilman Motsavage agreed to remove his name from the sponsor list of the legislation in order to provide the new administration time to review the proposal.
