The meeting of the Board of Electrical Examiners was held on November 05, 2014 and called to order at 10:30am .

Items discussed were:

1. Brian Adee was present to explain his inspections that were questioned by Charles Joslyn. He stated that he may have missed the grounding at 2 High Street. The ground was subsequently fixed. He stated that he had informed the owner, verbally, that the disconnect(s) at 25 Chenango Street were to be moved prior to final inspection. No final inspection was issued. There is no written record of this communication with the owner. Mr. Adee alleged that he informed the property owner, verbally, that some type of enclosure had to be installed around the electric service at 24 Tremont Avenue, because he observed that the panel was installed in a manner in which it is vulnerable to weather conditions. There is no written record of this communication with the owner. There are no approved plans to provide this enclosure. Mr. Adee was asked, by Mr. Costello, whether he had any written documentation to support the statements he (Adee) made about the above-described issues. Mr. Adee responded that he would have to get prior authorization from Commonwealth Inspection Services before he could provide any documentation, if and where he had it. During the course of discussion between all parties, Mr. Adee stated that he did not understand why design plans were necessary for the installation or inspection of an electric service. Mr. Adee also questioned the qualifications of the Electrical Inspector, Charles Joslyn. The discussion with Mr. Adee ended with the understanding that Mr. Adee would receive a formal response to his request for reinstatement as an authorized inspector, at a future date.
2. Minutes of the October meeting were read and approved following motion by Costello, seconded by McDevitt, by unanimous voice vote.
3. Prometric exam fees are paid from the general fund; exam fees for the plumbing exam will be reviewed.

There being no further business before this Board a motion was made by Costello, seconded by Emmons, to adjourn at 11:15am, by unanimous voice vote.

The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday December 03, 2014 at 10:30am.
