OLD BUSINESS

Speed Sign Placement

G. Holmes reported that the signs have not yet been ordered. The signs are quite expensive so he is going to look into this further and report back with options and costs.

NEW BUSINESS

135 Conklin Avenue

T. Martinez requested that the Traffic Board review the proposed plans for Mt. Fresh Dairy at 135 Conklin Avenue. Two issues were of concern. First, should the curb openings be wider than the current 30 feet? Second, does the board have any recommendations for the new business at this location. W. Lescault reported that Traffic recommends keeping to 30 feet and covering the One Hour signs across the street for now.

North Shore Drive

A citizen requested that the Yield sign on North Shore Drive be replaced with a Stop sign. Traffic reported that the amount of accidents at this location does not warrant a change in the sign. The line of sign is good for a yield sign.

79 Court Street Parking Issues

D. Jevlekides, a local restaurant owner reported to the board that she has been having parking issues on Court Street in front of her business at 79 Court Street. She also reported that the alley way behind her building is quite dangerous at night because it is poorly lit. B. Berg asked D. Jevlekides to give the Traffic Board until the April meeting to find a solution for the parking and alley ways.
