

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## Qualifications and Experience

It is the understanding of the Wladis Law Firm, P.C. that the City of Binghamton (the "City") desires to engage a professional grant researcher and writer to provide high quality grant writing services to various city departments on an as needed basis. The services shall include assistance with identification, preparation, application for and administration of grants from federal, local and state entities and which relate to various functions of the City. 6. *Cape Vincent*: Worked with MetalCraft Marine, Inc. to submit a successful proposal to the North Country Regional Economic Development Council that resulted in a \$400,000 funding award to expand the MetalCraft facility and increase employment at the site
7. *Cortland County*: Assisted with a grant application to the New York State Department of Homeland Security which resulted in a \$4MM award to implement upgrades to the County's emergency communications system.
8. *Onondaga County*: Wrote and submitted a Consolidated Funding Application which resulted in a \$350,000 award from Empire State Development for the renovation and reuse of an historic downtown building that, once completed, will house and consolidate several county offices that are currently spread throughout the Central New York region.

The Firm has cultivated excellent working relationships with a host of local, state and federal agencies, with elected officials and their staff members, as well as with private foundations and other organizations. As demonstrated above and in the illustrative examples below, the Firm has well surpassed the requirement of participating in the successful grant funding of at least \$10MM for municipal clients in the previous three years.

### Broome County

The Firm began assisting Broome County with its grant writing needs in 2012. In this first year, the County was awarded a grant in the amount of \$500,000 from Empire State Development for renovations to the Broome County Arena. This successful application for funding went through New York's Consolidated Funding Application/Regional Economic Development Council process. The Firm continued to successfully assist Broome County with its grant writing needs in 2013 which resulted in an award of \$1,008,090 via the Green Innovation Grant Program for the treatment and management of storm water at its Public Safety Facility, as well as \$1,250,000 via Empire State Development for infrastructure improvements to the Greater Binghamton Airport. ### Onondaga County

### Cayuga County

## ***Proposed Approach***

The Firm proposes to have one attorney and one grant writing professional act as the main points of contact with the City, and will delegate work within the Firm to the professionals whose qualifications and abilities are best suited to the particular individual matter. **Start Date:** Immediately upon award of contract

**Step One/Ongoing:** The Firm will meet with the Mayor, city department heads and other involved officials in order to ascertain funding needs, priority projects, and funding opportunities.

**Step Two/Ongoing:** Research in order to match funding opportunities with City projects and priorities; present suggestions to the department heads and other involved officials and schedule meetings to be attended by City officials and department heads with funding agencies in order to brief the agencies on City projects and priorities.
