## Federal & State Historic Preservation Tax Incentives Programs:

Many older commercial buildings are located in State & National Register Historic Districts. Restoration work may qualify under Federal and State historic tax credit programs. The State Historic Preservation Office manages both programs in conjunction with the National Park Service and the Internal Revenue Service. For information, see:

- 20% Federal tax credit for certified rehabilitation of certified historic structures
  - 20% NY State tax credit for certified rehabilitation of certified historic structures
  - 10% federal tax credit for rehabilitation of non-historic, non-residential buildings built before 1936
- Interior/exterior work qualifies as long as it follows City, state and federal preservation guidelines and obtains necessary approvals.

The BLDC's Board of Directors and community members provide input and expertise from a variety of sectors including finance, business, professional and organizations that represent low to moderate income populations.

### Our Mission:

The Binghamton Local Development Corporation exists to further sustainable economic development in the City of Binghamton by attracting new business, retaining and growing established business, building industrial and commercial capacity, promoting employment, and fostering entrepreneurship and innovation.

## BLDC Loan Programs

### Revolving Fund Loan

Up to 40% of the total project cost to a maximum of \$250k, whichever is less, terms to match security or collateral.

### Microenterprise Loan

Small business start-up and expansion; up to \$24k with maximum 5-year term.

### Commercial Façade Improvement Loan

Up to 75% of total project cost to a maximum of \$100k, maximum 7-year term.



### Rural Business Enterprise Grants Program: Green Jobs Revolving Loan Fund

- established to foster development of green jobs in the energy efficiency sector of the local contracting industry
- low-interest financing for Building Performance Institute (BPI) certified contracting businesses that demonstrate a need and have projects specifically related to NYSERDA energy-efficiency programs
- BLDC's Green Jobs Revolving Loan Fund can be used to purchase equipment; working capital, including inventory; and other project activities
- Minimum loan amount \$5,000; maximum loan amount \$80,000; 1 full-time job must be created for every \$35,000 loaned.
- 3% fixed interest rate

## New York State Energy Research & Development Authority

NYSERDA offers technical/financial assistance to help small businesses improve energy efficiency and reduce energy costs.

**Energy Audit Program** offers free energy audits for small businesses to help identify opportunities to improve energy efficiency and suggests improvements to reduce energy costs.

**Existing Facilities Program** has incentives for customers interested in purchasing/installing energy efficient equipment such as lighting, HVAC and variable frequency drives at their facility.

**Green Jobs Green New York Small Business Energy Efficiency Financing Program** works with lenders statewide to provide eligible small businesses with access to low-interest energy efficiency project financing.
