LANDSCAPING NOTES:

- 1) ALL NEW PLANT MATERIAL SHALL CONFORM TO THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF NURSERYMAN'S "AMERICAN STANDARD FOR NURSERY STOCK - ANSI Z60.1" FOR CALIPERS, HEIGHTS, BALL SIZES, ETC.
- 2) DISPOSE OF SUBSOIL REMOVED FROM LANDSCAPE EXCAVATIONS. DO NOT MIX WITH PLANTING SOIL OR USE AS BACKFILL.
- 3) BACKFILL TO BE THREE PARTS TOPSOIL TO ONE PART PEAT MOSS BY VOLUME. PLACE IN LAYERS, WATER EACH LAYER UNTIL SETTLED.
- 4) FOR MASS PLANTING, EXCAVATE ENTIRE BED AND BACKFILL WITH ABOVE MATERIAL.
- 5) CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE CODES AND ORDINANCES REGARDING LANDSCAPING.
- 6) IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO ESTABLISH A HEALTHY STAND OF GRASS ON ALL SEEDED AREAS.
- 7) PLANTING BEDS AND MULCH ARE TO BE RAISED. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INSTALL BLACK FABRIC MESH UNDER THE MULCH TO PREVENT WEED GROWTH.
- 8) PLANTING SHALL OCCUR AT A TIME OF YEAR WHEN VEGETATION SURVIVAL AND GROWTH CAN BE ANTICIPATED. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE WATERING AND THE MAINTENANCE OF ALL LANDSCAPED AREAS FOR THIRTY (30) DAYS FOLLOWING THE PLANTING OF THE GRASS AND SHRUBS. A TWO (2) YEAR WARRANTY IS TO BE PROVIDED FOR ALL LANDSCAPE MATERIAL, WHICH WILL INCLUDE REPLACEMENT OF ANY VEGETATION THAT FAILS TO THRIVE WITHIN THAT TIME FRAME.
- 9) GENERAL CONTRACTOR IS TO CLEAN ENTIRE SITE OF ALL CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS AND RAKE ENTIRE SITE.
