A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR  
TO ENTER INTO AN EXTENSION  
AGREEMENT WITH THE BINGHAMTON CITY  
SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR SCHOOL RESOURCE  
OFFICERS AT THE HIGH SCHOOL AND  
MIDDLE SCHOOLS FOR 2020-2021

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to renew its agreement with the Binghamton City School District for School Resource Officers at the High School and Middle Schools, whereby the City agrees to provide the High School and each Middle School with one (1) police officer designated by the Chief of Police, and that the Binghamton City School District will pay the City for providing such police officer as provided in said agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to renew an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the Binghamton City School District for School Resource Officers at the High School and Middle Schools for 2020-2021.

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PERMANENT  
ORDINANCE O20-56 TO CLARIFY THE SCOPE  
OF DONATIONS TO THE OURSPACE  
RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the OurSpace Project at Recreation Park was destroyed by fire on or about June 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Ordinance O20-56, dated July 8, 2020, the City agreed to accept donations for reconstruction of the OurSpace Project at Recreation Park; and

WHEREAS, the intent of Permanent Ordinance O20-56 was to accept all donations, however the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton has suggested that the scope of acceptable donations should be clarified; and

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to facilitate receipt of all donations by amending Section 1 of Permanent Ordinance O20-56 and to accept all donations to date.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Permanent Ordinance O20-56 is hereby deleted and replaced as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation are authorized to accept insurance proceeds and all donations, including, but not limited to, money, materials, equipment, tools, in kind contributions, labor, and services, for the OurSpace Reconstruction Project at Recreation Park without further approval from City Council.

Section 2. That all donations to date of money, materials, equipment, tools, in kind contributions, labor, and services that were approved by the Mayor or the Commissioner of Parks and Recreation are hereby accepted.

Section 3. That other than as amended herein, Permanent Ordinance O20-56 remains in full force and effect.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
