Section 1. That § 400-20 of the Code of the City of Binghamton, entitled *Composition; Chairperson*, is hereby deleted and replaced as follows:

§ 400-20. Composition; Chairperson [Amended 8-15-1983 by Ord. No. 133-83, Amended 10-23-2013 by Ord. No 13-_____]

The Traffic Board shall consist of the Deputy Commissioner of Public Safety, who shall be the Chairperson of the Board; an officer from the Bureau of Police, to be appointed by the Chief of Police; a member of the Department Public Works, to be appointed by the Commissioner of Public Works; a member of the Engineering Department, to be appointed by the City Engineer; and a member of the City Council, to be appointed by the President of the Council.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING OUT-OF-TITLE STIPENDS FOR THE SENIOR PLANNER AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT PLANNER

WHEREAS, due to a leave of absence of the City of Binghamton’s Chief Planner, the Senior Planner has assumed fifty percent (50%) of the duties of the Chief Planner, and the Sustainable Development Planner has assumed twenty-five percent (25%) of the duties of the Chief Planner; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Planning, Housing and Community Development has requested an out-of-title stipend of \$1,428.00 for the Senior Planner, and an out-of-title stipend of \$714.00 for the Sustainable Development Planner, such stipends to be divided among the remaining pay periods in 2013.
