AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE POLICE
BUREAU 2014 BUDGET, TO TEMPORARILY
ADD ONE POLICE OFFICER, INCREASING
THE TOTAL NUMBER OF POLICE OFFICERS
FROM 131 TO 132

WHEREAS, the Police Chief of the City of Binghamton finds it necessary and proper to temporarily increase Police Department personnel by one (1) Police Officer position from March 4, 2013 to June 12, 2014, in anticipation of a Police Officer retirement; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has requested this amendment to the Police Department 2014 budget in order to hire a new recruit on March 4, 2014, to train in the Police Academy, which would temporarily increase the total number of Police Officers from 131 to 132 from March 4, 2014 to June 12, 2014; and

WHEREAS, funds for this additional Police Officer position are currently available in budget line A3120.51000 (Personal Services).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in special session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the Police Bureau 2014 budget to temporarily increase Police Department personnel by one (1) Police Officer position from March 4, 2013 to June 12, 2014, within budget line A3120.51000 (Personal Services).

Section 2. That funds are currently available in budget line A3120.51000 (Personal Services) and in budget line A9030.58000B (Social Security) to fund the additional Police Officer position and associated benefits for through June 12, 2014.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
