WHEREAS, a project for the Front Street Pavement Restoration, P.I.N. 975386 (the "Project"), is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-Federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the Federal and non-Federal share of the Preliminary Engineering work at a cost of \$15,000.00 which is available from budget line A1440.51000 (Engineering – Personal Services).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Council of the City of Binghamton hereby approves the above-subject Project; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Binghamton hereby authorizes the City of Binghamton to pay in the first instance 100% of the Federal and non-Federal share of the costs of the Preliminary Engineering work for the Project or portions thereof; and be it further

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the Federal and non-Federal share of the Preliminary Engineering work at a cost of \$80,000.

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 400-24
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF
BINGHAMTON, REGARDING THE
MAINTENANCE OF THE TRAFFIC CODE

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to amend the Code of the City of Binghamton, § 400-24, *Effective date of orders, rules and regulations*, assigning the maintenance of the Traffic Code to the City Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That § 400-24 of the Code of the City of Binghamton, entitled *Effective date of orders, rules and regulations*, is hereby amended as follows:

§400-24. Effective date of orders, rules and regulations. [Amended 2-19-2014 by Ord. No 14-__]

Orders, rules and regulations adopted by the Traffic Board shall become effective as soon as the same are filed with the City Court and City Clerk. It shall be the duty of the City Clerk to maintain the Traffic Code, and to amend any portion of the Traffic Code as may be necessary upon receipt of any order, rule or regulation adopted by the Traffic Board.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
