**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE
OF 194 MURRAY STREET TO TROUT BROOK
HOUSING DEVELOPMENT FUND
CORPORATION FOR \$8,000**

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2009 the Council of the City of Binghamton adopted Permanent Resolution 09-55, "A Resolution Authorizing the Sale of Properties as part of the Restore NY Program"; and

WHEREAS, as part of the sale of properties in the Restore NY Program, City Council approved the transfer of 194 Murray Street to First Ward Action Council for \$8,000; and

WHEREAS, First Ward Action Council has assigned the right to purchase 194 Murray Street to Trout Brook Housing Development Fund Corporation; and

WHEREAS, given the four year delay and transfer of rights to purchase 194 Murray Street the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to reapprove the sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Binghamton is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for sale and to execute to execute all documents, approved as to form and content of the Office of Corporation Counsel, as may be necessary to transfer 194 Murray Street, Binghamton, New York, Tax Parcel No. 144.80-4-25 to Trout Brook Housing Development Fund Corporation for \$8,000, to be paid by certified or local bank check.
