**RESOLUTION**

**AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE 2013  
BUDGET OF THE BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON  
CITY JOINT SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITY**

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is a joint owner of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Treatment Facilities (the "JSTF") with the Village of Johnson City; and

WHEREAS, the JSTF is operated pursuant to an Intermunicipal Agreement as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Sewage Board's ("Sewage Board") has requested a modification in the JSTF's 2013 operating budget to correct a condition of inverted compensation and thereby pay a base salary commensurate with the management and supervisory duties of the Laboratory Director/Safety Manager position.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the JSTF Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to transfer \$5,092 from the JSTF's 2013 operating budget Line J8130.51699 (Wage/Salary Adjustments/Stipends) to budget line J8130.51000 (Personnel Services [Laboratory Director/Safety Manager]).

Section 2. That the City of Binghamton hereby approves an increase annual base salary of the Laboratory Director/Safety Manager from "up to \$48,960" to "up to \$55,302".


Section 3. Upon making the above transfer and increase, the Laboratory Director/Safety Manager position shall not be eligible for any salary adjustment stipend compensation during the remainder of 2013.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by a majority of the Council of the City of Binghamton and a majority of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Johnson City.
