AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A BUDGET  
MODIFICATION TO ACCOMMODATE THE  
SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM, AND TO  
ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF  
UNDERSTANDING WITH THE BINGHAMTON  
CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton and the Binghamton City School District have collaborated to expand the Summer Enrichment Program; and

WHEREAS, the City and the School District wish to execute a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") effective as of July 1, 2013, through August 16, 2013, to provide for funding and resources to support the Summer Enrichment Program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate to increase estimated revenue and expenditure budget lines to accept and utilize such funds as provided in the MOU.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with the Binghamton City School District for the Summer Enrichment Program effective from July 1, 2013, through August 16, 2013 as attached hereto.

Section 2. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2013 estimated revenue line A.44820 (Youth Programs) in the amount of \$23,000 and to increase 2013 expenditure line A7140.51800 (Youth Programs) in amount of \$23,000.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.

**Memorandum of Understanding  
Between  
Binghamton City School District  
And  
The City of Binghamton**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is an alliance of and between the Binghamton City School District (BCSD) and the City of Binghamton (COB).

***I. Purpose and Scope***

The purpose of the MOU is to create a framework of cooperation between BCSD and City of Binghamton to:


- Collaborate on mutually beneficial summer programming pertaining to school age children, including training, community outreach, funding opportunities, and evaluation.
- Provide assistance and advocacy for enrollment, attendance of students enrolled, and the programming that addresses the academic and social development of children in attendance in the summer program, *Summer Enrichment in the City*.
- Engage in shared services as outlined in support of summer programming for school-aged children.

***II. Responsibilities***

Each organization will appoint a person to serve as the official contact and coordinate the activities of the organization in carrying out this MOU.

*The City of Binghamton agrees to:*

- Allocate resources to support programming of Summer Enrichment in the City through the Parks and Recreation department and any other relevant department to ensure a successful program occurs.
  - Provide supervision and oversight for each program location from 8:30 through 3:00, Monday through Friday from July 8, 2013 through August 16, 2013.

- Hire staff to adequately serve the population of students enrolled in the program.

*The Binghamton City School District agrees to:*

- Allocate resources to support programming of Summer Enrichment in the City to ensure a successful program.
- Provide program supervision from 8:15 to 12:30, Monday through Thursday from July 8, 2013 through August 16, 2013.
- Purchase the services of the City of Binghamton to hire up to 20 Recreation Leaders, for four (4) hours per day Monday through Thursday (11:00am—3:00pm) and six and one half (6.5) hours on Friday (8:30am—3:00pm), and 1 Site Supervisor, not to exceed a total of \$23,000. The district should receive invoices for such services no later than August 31, 2013.

*III. Terms of Understanding*

The terms of this MOU is for the period of July 1 through August 16.

*IV. Modification/Termination*

This MOU constitutes an agreement between the parties hereto. This MOU may be modified, altered, revised, extended or renewed by mutual written consent of all parties, by the issuance of written amendment, signed and dated by all the parties.
