ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND  
FUNDING A TEMPORARY POLICE OFFICER  
POSITION IN THE 2013 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to amend the Police Department 2013 budget to establish the position of Temporary Police Officer within budget line A3120.51800 (Police—Temporary Help) at a rate of \$28.50/hour ~~for no more than twenty (20) hours/week~~, for a period not to exceed three (3) months; and

WHEREAS, funds are available from budget line A1990.55000 (Contingency) for this purpose.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the Police Department 2013 budget to establish the position of Temporary Police Officer within budget line A3120.51800 (Police—Temporary Help) at a rate of \$28.50/hour ~~for no more than twenty (20) hours/week~~, for a period not to exceed three (3) months.


Section 2. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$8,550.00 from budget line A1990.55000 (Contingency) to budget line A3120.518000 (Police—Temporary Help) and to transfer \$655.00 from budget line A1990.55000 (Contingency) to budget line A9030.58000B (Social Security) to fund the position and associated benefits for the remainder of 2013.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
