**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2013 CODE
ENFORCEMENT BUDGET TO DEFUND A
CODE ENFORCEMENT SUPERVISOR
POSITION AND TO FUND A NEW CODE
ENFORCEMENT OFFICER POSITION**

WHEREAS, the Supervisor of Building Construction, Zoning & Code Enforcement has requested an amendment to the Code Enforcement 2013 budget to defund a Code Enforcement Supervisor position and to transfer such funds to a new Code Enforcement Officer position to reflect a change in staff organization.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to transfer up to \$7,937.00 from budget line A8664.51000 (Personal Services—Code Enforcement Supervisor) to budget line A8664.51000 (Personal Services—Code Enforcement Officer), to fund a new Code Enforcement Officer position at an annual salary of \$33,994.00 for the remainder of 2013.

Section 2. That the remaining balance in budget line A8664.51000 (Personal Services—Code Enforcement Supervisor) shall be transferred to budget line A1990.55000 (Contingency), retaining the position of Code Enforcement Supervisor in the 2013 budget at \$0.00.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect September 28, 2013.
