
AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY
OF BINGHAMTON TO ACCEPT UP TO \$15,000
FROM THE NYS DIVISION OF CRIMINAL
JUSTICE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Binghamton Police Department is eligible to receive up to \$15,000 from the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services ("NYS DCJS") for miscellaneous expenses related to the crime analysis center.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with NYS DCJS to accept up to \$15,000 for miscellaneous expenses related to the crime analysis center; and be it further

RESOLVED that upon approval of the agreement by the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to establish a budget line in the Binghamton Police Department 2013 budget for the acceptance of up to \$15,000 from NYS DCJS for miscellaneous expenses related to the crime analysis center.
