FROM BUDGET LINE A8160.52600
(SANITATION, EQUIPMENT) TO BUDGET
LINE A1640.54110 (CENTRAL GARAGE,
VEHICLE PARTS TO COVER A SHORTAGE OF
FUNDS FOR VEHICLE PARTS

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works finds it proper and necessary to transfer funds within the Department of Public Works 2013 budget in order to cover a shortage of funds for vehicle parts; and

WHEREAS, the budget transfer was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on September 18, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the Department of Public Works 2013 budget to transfer \$6,000.00 from budget line A8160.52600 (Equipment) to budget line A1640.54110 (Vehicle Parts).

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
