AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AN ORDER OF
THE BINGHAMTON TRAFFIC BOARD TO
REMOVE THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL FROM THE
INTERSECTION OF ST. JOHN AVENUE AND
LEROY STREET

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 400-26 of the Code of the City of Binghamton, entitled *Authority of Council to amend or repeal orders, rules and regulations*, the Council of the City of Binghamton has the authority to enact ordinances to repeal or amend any order, rule or regulation adopted by the Binghamton Traffic Board; and

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2013, the Binghamton Traffic Board adopted an order to remove the traffic signal located at the intersection of St. John Avenue and Leroy Street; and

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to repeal such order.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Binghamton does hereby repeal the order of the Traffic Board adopted on September 19, 2013 authorizing the removal of the traffic signal located at the intersection of St. John Avenue and Leroy Street.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
