BUDGET LINES IN THE ECONOMIC

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES, SUBSCRIPTION,
DUES & MEMBERSHIPS, AND POSTAGE

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to establish new budget lines in the 2013 Economic Development budget for Professional Services, Office Supplies, Professional Services, Subscription, Dues & Memberships, and Postage; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to approve this amendment to the budget.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to establish budget lines A6989.54101 (Office Supplies); A6989.54410 (Professional Services); A6989.54702 (Subscription, Dues & Memberships); and A6989.54652 (Postage) in the 2013 Economic Development budget.


Section 2. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to establish an initial balance of \$0.00 in each budget line.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
