**AN ORDINANCE TO ACQUIRE FORECLOSED,
BLIGHTED PROPERTIES ON CHENANGO
STREET TO SUPPORT REVITALIZATION OF
THE NORTH SIDE SMALL BUSINESS
CORRIDOR**

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to acquire foreclosed and blighted properties on Chenango Street to support revitalization of the North Side Small Business Corridor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to increase revenue budget line A42410 (Rental of Real Property) by \$13,000 and to increase revenue budget line A42189 (Other Home and Comm Services) by \$13,500, and to establish and fund such budget line A1364.54682 (Purchase of Real Property); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment approved the budget modifications on December 4, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to increase revenue budget line A.42410 (Rental of Real Property) by \$13,000 and to increase revenue budget line A42189 (Other Home and Comm Services) by \$13,500.

Section 2. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to establish budget line A1364.54682 (Purchase of Real Property) and to fund such budget line with a total of \$26,500.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
