ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2013 BUDGET TRANSFERRING \$25,000 FROM BUDGET LINE A9015.58000 (PFRS) AND \$39,000 FROM BUDGET LINE M1910.54000 (PROVISION FOR INCURRED LOSS) TO BUDGET LINE A3410.51000 (FIRE PERSONAL SERVICES) TO PAY FOR ONE YEAR'S SALARY OF A DECEASED FIREFIGHTER

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to transfer funds within the 2013 budget for one year's salary to be paid to the estate of a deceased Fire Fighter; and

WHEREAS, the proposed transfers were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on December 4, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2013 budget transferring \$25,000 from budget line A9015.58000 (PFRS) and \$39,000 from budget line M1910.54900 (Provision for Incurred Loss) to budget line A3410.51000 (Fire-Personal Services) for one year's salary to be paid to the estate of a deceased Fire Fighter.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
