ORDINANCE

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND
FUNDING AN EXPENSE LINE IN THE 2014
BUDGET FOR THE ZONING BOARD OF
APPEALS AND PLANNING COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Acting Director of Planning, Housing and Community Development requests to establish and fund new budget lines in the 2014 budget for the Zoning Board of Appeals and Planning Commission for the purpose of reducing cost to applicants related to certified mailings and newspaper notices; and

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton wishes to increase estimated revenue line A.41240 (Comptroller's Fees) by \$11,200 in order to fund the new budget lines in the 2014 budget for the Zoning Board of Appeals and Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton approves this amendment to the 2014 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to establish budget lines A8010.54650 (Legal Ads) and A8010.54102 (General Operating Supplies) in the 2014 Zoning Board of Appeals budget.

Section 2. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to establish budget lines A8020.54650 (Legal Ads) and A8020.54102 (General Operating Supplies) in the 2014 Planning Commission budget.


Section 3. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are authorized and directed to increase estimated revenue line A.41240 (Comptroller Fees) by \$11,200; increase expenditure line A8010.54650 (Legal Ads) by \$2,000; increase expenditure line A8010.54102 (General Operating Supplies) by \$1,800; increase expenditure line A8020.54650 (Legal Ads) by \$4,000; and increase expenditure line A8020.54102 (General Operating Supplies) by \$3,400.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
