**ORDINANCE**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2014  
POLICE BUREAU BUDGET ADDING TWO  
POLICE OFFICER POSITIONS EFFECTIVE  
JULY 1, 2014, AND INCREASING ESTIMATED  
REVENUE TO FUND SUCH SALARIES**

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Binghamton has requested an amendment to the 2014 Police Bureau budget to add two (2) Police Officer positions effective July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a School Resource Officer ("SRO") Agreement with the Binghamton City School District, as approved in Resolution 14-41 of even date herewith, two (2) Police Officers shall be designated by the Chief of Police as SROs to be located at the middle schools, and that the BCSD will pay the City for providing such SROs in accordance with said agreement;

WHEREAS, in order to receive payment from the Binghamton City School District for such positions, it is necessary to increase estimated revenue; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to adopt such amendments to the Police Department 2014 budget and estimated revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to increase budget line A3120.51000 (Personal Services) by \$40,118 and to add two (2) additional Police Officer, Probationary A @ \$40,118/yr positions.

Section 2. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to increase revenue line A42260 (Public Safety Svc – Other Govts: Binghamton Schools, Resource Officer) by \$40,118.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect July 1, 2014.

I HEREBY CERTIFY that the above described funds are unencumbered and available.
