**ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE  
TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM VARIOUS  
DEPARTMENTS TO FUND THE  
BINGHAMTON PARKING STUDY

WHEREAS, the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2014 budget, transferring \$50,000 from various budget lines in to fund a comprehensive downtown parking study and strategic plan for the City of Binghamton; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget transfers were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on March 12, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to approve the transfers.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2014 budget to fund a comprehensive downtown parking study and strategic plan for the City of Binghamton, transferring such funds as follows:


