ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE  
DONATION OF 10 ALFRED STREET AND  
\$30,600 IN LIEU OF PROPERTY DISPOSITION

WHEREAS, the owner of the 10 Alfred Street, Binghamton has expressed a desire to donate said property to the City of Binghamton; and

WHEREAS the owner of the property shall submit a payment to the City of Binghamton of \$30,600 in lieu of the disposition of structures on the property.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract and to execute all necessary and appropriate documentation, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to accept the donation of 10 Alfred Street and \$30,600 in lieu of the disposition of structures on the property.

Section 2. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to increase 2015 estimate revenue line A42705 (Gifts & Donations) by \$30,600,

Section 3. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to increase the 2015 expenditure line A1364.54681 (Acquired Property for Taxes) by \$1,500 and to increase the 2015 expenditure line A1364.54470 (Demolitions) by \$29,100.
