**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VARIOUS
TRANSFERS IN THE 2014 JOINT SEWAGE
TREATMENT PLANT BUDGET TO PAY FOR
LEGAL SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Johnson City and the Council of the City of Binghamton jointly approve the annual budget of the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board ("JSB"); and

WHEREAS, Inter-Municipal Agreement No. X sets forth the procedure for the JSB to request approval of budget transfers and modifications during the year or within 30 days thereafter so long as any transfers do not increase the JSB's budgeted expenses for the year; and

WHEREAS, the JSB requests a transfer of funds to pay for legal services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Joint Sewage Fiscal Officer is directed and authorized to transfer \$34,266.39 from budget line J8130.54150 (Chemicals) to budget line J8130.54410.J0BAF (Professional Services - BAF) and transfer \$27,559.85 from budget line J8130.54150 (Chemicals) to budget line J8130.54430.J0BAF (Legal Services - BAF).

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by a majority of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Johnson City and a majority of the Council of the City of Binghamton.
