AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
ABANDONMENT OF WATER STREET RIGHT
OF WAY AS A PUBLIC STREET

WHEREAS, General City Law § 20.7 permits a city to discontinue a public street if it is no longer necessary for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Water Street right-of-way has not been used for a public street; and

WHEREAS, in order to confirm that Water Street right-of-way has not been used as a public street, the Council of the City of Binghamton duly advertised and held a public hearing on May 20, 2015, to officially abandon the Water Street right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that Water Street right-of-way has not been used as a public street and is no longer necessary for any public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Water Street right-of-way is not a public street and is no longer necessary for any public purpose.

Section 2. That the Department of Public Works is authorized to take necessary action to properly discontinue the Water Street right-of-way.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
