AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 307-3
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF
BINGHAMTON REGARDING PEDDLER
EXCEPTIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton wishes to amend Chapter 307-3, *Exceptions*, of the Code of the City of Binghamton to eliminate §307-3.A.(4) as it relates to peddling and soliciting.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That §307-3.A.(4) of the Code of the City of Binghamton, entitled *Exceptions*, is hereby deleted as provided below and the remaining sections will be renumbered accordingly:

§307-3. *Exceptions* [Amended 10-5-1981 by Ord. No. 183-81; Amended 6-17-2015 by Ord. No 15-36]

A. Nothing in this article shall be held to apply to:

- (1) Any sales conducted pursuant to statute or by order of any court.
- (2) Home delivery of daily or weekly newspapers.
- (3) Any person selling personal property at wholesale to dealers in such articles.
- ~~(4) Persons having an established place of business within the City or their employees for soliciting orders from customers and delivering the same.~~
- (5) Farmers or truck gardeners who themselves or through their employees vend, sell or dispose products of their own farms or gardens.
- (6) Persons licensed pursuant to § 32, Article 4, of the General Business Law of the State of New York (veterans) or to § 10, Article 2, of the General City Law of the State of New York (adult blind persons).

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
