AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE  
DONATION OF 16 SECOND STREET AND  
\$20,000 IN LIEU OF PROPERTY DISPOSITION

WHEREAS, the owner of 16 Second Street, Binghamton, New York has expressed a desire to donate said property to the City of Binghamton; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the property shall submit a payment to the City of Binghamton of \$20,000 in lieu of the disposition of structures on the property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment approved the acceptance of 16 Second Street on June 10, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Mayor, or his designee, of the City of Binghamton, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract and to execute all necessary and appropriate documentation, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to accept donation of 16 Second Street and \$20,000 in lieu of the disposition of structures on the property; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to increase 2015 estimate revenue line A42705 (Gifts & Donations) by \$20,000; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to increase the 2015 expenditure line A1364.54470 (Demolitions) by \$20,000.
