AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING TRANSFER
IN THE 2015 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
WORKS BUDGET TO COVER THE COST OF
HOT MIX AND THERMAL PLASTIC RINGS

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2015 Public Works budget to transfer \$15,000 from budget line A5182.54444 (Street Lighting) to budget line A5110.54130 (Construction Material) to cover the cost of hot mix and thermal plastic rings; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget transfer was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on October 28, 2015; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton wishes to approve this transfer.

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2015 Public Works budget to transfer \$15,000 from budget line A5182.54444 (Street Lighting) to budget line A5110.54130 (Construction Material) to cover the cost of hot mix and thermal plastic rings.
