ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 124-17,  
ANNUAL LEAVE, IN THE CODE OF THE CITY OF  
BINGHAMTON

WHEREAS, the Code of the City of Binghamton §124-17, *Annual Leave* provides a schedule of accrual of annual leave for Officers and employees; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has requested the option to award vacation time commensurate with experience to attract and retain employees;

WHEREAS, this amendment will sunset and be null and void as of December 31, 2016, unless extended by City Council.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton has determined this amendment to be acceptable.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in special session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Code of the City of Binghamton §124-17, *Annual Leave* paragraph (1) is amended as follows:

Officers and employees of the City of Binghamton (the "City") shall earn and accumulate annual leave days at the rate of 1/2 day per semimonthly period *or as may be awarded by the Mayor up to 20 days a year*. An officer or employee shall not earn annual leave credit for any semimonthly pay period unless he or she is in full pay status for at least seven workdays during such semimonthly pay period. *If the Mayor awards annual leave days in excess of 1/2 day per semimonthly period and the additional annual leave days below, then additional annual leave days will not accrue until total annual leave days awarded equal total annual leave days accumulated. The amended language herein in italics will sunset and be null and void as of December 31, 2016, unless extended by City Council.*

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.


