**ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE POLICE BUREAU 2016 BUDGET, TO TEMPORARILY ADD ONE POLICE OFFICER, INCREASING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF POLICE OFFICERS FROM 138 to 139

WHEREAS, the Police Chief of the City of Binghamton finds it necessary and proper to amend the Police Bureau 2016 budget to temporarily increase Police Bureau personnel by one (1) Police Officer (Officer Probationary) position from February 29, 2016, to March 31, 2016, pending an anticipated retirement; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this temporary increase is to hire a new recruit starting on February 29, 2016, to train in the Police Academy, which would temporarily increase the total number of Police Officers from 138 to 139 from February 29, 2016, to March 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, funds for this additional Police Officer (Officer Probationary) position are currently available in budget line A3120.51000 (Personal Services).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in special session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the Police Bureau 2016 budget to temporarily increase Police Bureau personnel by one (1) Police Officer (Officer Probationary) position from February 29, 2016, to March 31, 2016, within budget line A3120.51000 (Personal Services).

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
