AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2016

WHEREAS, the Director of Personnel and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2016 Personnel budget to transfer \$6,875 from budget line A1990.55000 (Contingency) to A1430.54410 (Professional Services) to pay for the 2016 Anti-Harassment Training; and


WHEREAS, such budget amendment was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on April 27, 2016.
