AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CDBG
BUDGET TO CLOSE THE HPRP PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Renewal ("HUD") provided a grant for a Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re Hosing (HPRP) Program in the City of Binghamton; and

WHEREAS, the program was completed in 2013 and there is a balance of grant funds to be recaptured by HUD; and

WHEREAS, the Grants Administrator and Comptroller find it proper and necessary to amend the Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") budget to decrease revenue and expenses to close out the HPRP program; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on August 17, 2016.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Grants Administrator and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the CDBG budget as follows:
