**ORDINANCE**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2019 CODE  
ENFORCEMENT BUDGET TO EQUALIZE  
CODE INSPECTOR SALARIES**

WHEREAS, the Director of Code Enforcement and the Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2019 Code Enforcement budget to equalize Code Inspector salaries; and

WHEREAS, all Code Inspector salaries will be equalized at \$33,632 and this amendment will have no effect on the total 2019 Code Enforcement budget; and

WHEREAS, such amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on April 17, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2019 Code Enforcement budget as follows:

- (i) \$2,625 decrease to budget line A8664.51000 (Per Ser.-Code Inspector)
- (ii) \$84 increase to budget line A8664.51000 (Per Ser.-Code Inspector)
- (iii) \$1,448 increase to budget line A8664.51000 (Per Ser.-Code Inspector [VACANT])
- (iv) \$1,094 increase to budget line A8664.51000 (Per Ser.-Code Inspector)

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
