ORDINANCE

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE DONATION
OF 12 BROAD AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the owner of 12 Broad Avenue, Binghamton, New York, has offered to donate said property to the City of Binghamton; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment approved the donation on April 17, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Binghamton, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract and to execute all necessary and appropriate documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to accept donation of 12 Broad Avenue, Binghamton, New York.

Section 2. That the donation of said property is subject to the following conditions: (i) that all taxes through June 30, 2019, water/sewer bills, liens, and any other debts related to the property are paid and (ii) the City can obtain marketable title.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
