**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF
44 HAWLEY STREET TO THE PEOPLE OF THE
STATE OF NEW YORK**

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton is the purported owner of certain real property located at 44 Hawley Street, Binghamton, New York, Tax Parcel No. 160.49-1-18 (the "Premises"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Permanent Ordinance 69-39, dated February 17, 1969, the City of Binghamton agreed to enter into a Binghamton Governmental Civic Center Tripartite Agreement ("Tripartite Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Tripartite Agreement requires the City to transfer the Premises to the People of the State of New York; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment approved and recommended sale of the Premises on February 13, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain by at least a three-fourths vote as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of Binghamton is hereby authorized to execute all necessary and appropriate documentation, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to transfer the Premises to the People of the State of New York.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
