**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2019 PARKS
BUDGET TO REINSTATE SR. PARK
MAINTAINER AND DEFUND A LABORER
POSITION**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Binghamton passed Permanent Ordinance 19-01, dated January 9, 2019, which approved a budget amendment to defund Sr. Park Maintainer and add an additional Laborer in the Parks Department; and

WHEREAS, the Acting Commissioner of the Parks & Recreation Department and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2019 Parks budget to reinstate the Sr. Park Maintainer at an annual salary of \$44,563 and defund a Laborer position at an annual salary of \$37,388; and

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on July 2, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2019 Parks budget to reinstate the Sr. Park Maintainer at an annual salary of \$44,563 and defund a Laborer position at an annual salary of \$37,388, and to transfer funds as follows:
