ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019
FINANCE BUDGET TO REALLOCATE FUNDS,
REDUCE SALARIES, DEFUND THE TITLE OF
FINANCE PAYROLL SPECIALIST AND ADD
PAYROLL ASSISTANT, AND TO FUND
TEMPORARY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Comptroller finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2019 Finance budget to: (i) transfer funds to provide for a retirement pay-out for the Payroll Supervisor; (ii) thereafter, to reduce the salary of the Payroll Supervisor position from \$49,547 to \$45,794; (iii) to defund the title of "Finance Payroll Specialist," add the title "Payroll Assistant," and to transfer funds from the \$42,798 annual salary of the Finance Payroll Specialist to the Payroll Assistant at an annual salary of to \$35,000; and (iv) transfer funds from contingency for temporary services.

WHEREAS, such budget amendments were approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on July 2, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2019 Finance budget to transfer funds to provide for a retirement pay-out for the Payroll Supervisor as follows:

Section 2. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2019 Finance budget to reduce the salary of the Payroll Supervisor position from \$49,547 to \$45,794 from July 15, 2019, through December 31, 2019, as follows:

That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2019 Finance budget to defund the title of "Finance Payroll Specialist," add the title "Payroll Assistant," and to transfer funds from the \$42,798 annual salary of the Finance Payroll Specialist to the Payroll Assistant at an annual salary of to \$35,000 from July 22, 2019, through December 31, 2019, as follows:


