AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019
ENGINEERING AND DEPARTMENT OF
PUBLIC WORKS BUDGETS FOR TEMPORARY
SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works, City Engineer, and Comptroller of the City of Binghamton find it proper and necessary to amend the 2019 Engineering and Department of Public Works budgets for temporary services; and

WHEREAS, this budget transfer was approved by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment on July 17, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Comptroller and City Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend the 2019 Engineering and Department of Public Works budgets for temporary services as follows:

of City Streets)
13,000 A1440.51000 (Per Serv-Asst Engineer)
2,250 A1490.51000 (Per Serv-Payroll Clerk)

\$31,000


Transfer To (Increase):

\$31,000 A1440.51800 (Temp Services)

\$31,000
