AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2019
BINGHAMTON-JOHNSON CITY JOINT
SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITY BUDGET TO
INCREASE THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR SICK
TIME BUY-BACK AND NEW YORK STATE
UNEMPLOYMENT CLAIMS PAID

WHEREAS, the Binghamton-Johnson City Joint Sewage Board finds it proper and necessary to amend the 2019 BJCJSTF budget to transfer funds for sick time buy-back and for New York State Unemployment claims paid; and

WHEREAS, the BJCJSTF Board approved this budget amendment on February 13, 2020.


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:
