RESOLUTION

entitled

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
TRANSFER IN THE COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FY 39
BUDGET, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
CATHOLIC CHARITIES OF BROOME COUNTY
FOR THE USE OF FY 39 CDBG
FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$10,000

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton finds it proper and necessary to transfer funds in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) FY 39 budget and to enter into an agreement with RSVP for the use of Fiscal Year 39 Community Development Block Grant funding for an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:


Section 1. That the Comptroller and Treasurer of the City of Binghamton are hereby authorized and directed to amend FY 39 CDGB budget, transferring \$10,000 from budget line CD8676.533523.CDY39 (Crime Prevention) to budget line CD8676.533515.CDY39 (Human Services).

Section 2. That the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, Catholic Charities of Broome County for the use of Fiscal Year 39 Community Development Block Grant funding for an amount not to exceed \$10,000 to operate the Retired Senior Volunteer Program and that such funds shall be deducted from budget line CD8676.533515.CDY39 (Human Services).

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
