A RESOLUTION REDEDICATING STATE
STREET PARK AS PHELPS PARK

WHEREAS, in 1930 Z. Bennett Phelps provided 24 acres to the City of Binghamton on the north side to be developed as a park; and

WHEREAS, during that time the park was named Phelps Park in honor of the generous donation by Z. Bennett Phelps; and

WHEREAS, over time the park became unofficially known as State Street Park; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that State Street Park be rededicated as "Phelps Park" in honor of Z. Bennett Phelps.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that State Street Park be, and it hereby is, rededicated as "Phelps Park", and be it further

RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Binghamton directs that all official City maps, signs, and documents be corrected as they are reprinted or issued to refer to said park as "Phelps Park".
