WHEREAS, the Special Traffic Options Program for Driving While Intoxicated ("STOP-DWI") Task Force Unit has provided beneficial services to the City of Binghamton by reducing alcohol-impaired driving within the City; and


WHEREAS, Permanent Resolution No. 2011-463 adopted by the Broome County Legislature on November 17, 2011 provides grant funding to the Binghamton Police STOP-DWI Task Force Vehicle Program in the amount of \$33,000 for 2012; and

WHEREAS, Permanent Resolution No. 2012-497 adopted by the Broome County Legislature on December 21, 2012 provides grant funding to the Binghamton Police STOP-DWI Task Force Vehicle Program in the amount of \$27,500 for 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, as necessary to accept grant funding in the amount of \$33,000 for 2012 and \$27,500 for 2013 from Broome County for the STOP-DWI Task Force Unit.
