A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO RENEW A TWO-YEAR CONTRACT WITH
METRO INTERFAITH TO SERVE AS THE
BINGHAMTON HOMEOWNERSHIP
ACADEMY COORDINATOR

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton has entered into a contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant to execute a Community Development Block Grant Program for the purpose of supporting activities which will benefit low to moderate income families or individuals and to aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight in the City of Binghamton; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton desires to enter into an agreement with Metro Interfaith Housing Management, Inc. to serve as the Binghamton Homeownership Academy Coordinator for services related to the recruitment, marketing, administration and implementation of the City's housing program, in accordance with the attached proposal; and

WHEREAS, funds in the total amount of \$32,000 for 2013 and 2014 are currently available from budget line CD8668.54000.CDY38 (Contractual) in the amount of \$16,000 and CD8668.533509.CDY38 (Homeownership/Rehab) in the amount of \$16,000 or such amount may be paid from CD8668.54000.CDY39 (Contractual) if available and approved by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE, that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, with Metro Interfaith Housing Management, Inc. to serve as the Binghamton Homeownership Academy Coordinator in accordance with the attached proposal and that funds in the amount of \$32,000 for 2013 and 2014 be deducted from budget line CD8668.54000.CDY38 (Contractual) in the amount of \$16,000 and CD8668.533509.CDY38 (Homeownership/Rehab) in the amount of
