WHEREAS, the United Way of Broome County has requested to lease a portion of 108 Liberty Street, Binghamton, NY 13901, known as the Lee Barta Community Center, Tax Map No. 144.75-3-16, from March 1, 2013, through April 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Lee Barta Community Center will serve as office, program, and meeting space for the Healthy Lifestyles Coalition (HLC); and


WHEREAS, the Board of Estimate and Apportionment has approved such lease; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to provide the lease under terms and conditions as annexed hereto and subject to final approval by the Office of Corporation Counsel.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby:

RESOLVE that the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documentation, approved as to form and content by the Office of Corporation Counsel, to lease a portion of the Lee Barta Community Center to the United Way of Broome County Health Lifestyles Coalition for office space, coordination of programming, and community meetings as annexed hereto and subject to final approval by the Office of Corporation Counsel.
